CALL FOR SYMPOSIUM

It aims to explore the opportunities for coexistence, identify and preserve the contributions of scholars to the practice of coexistence, and promote its application in the future. This project aims to contribute to scientific, political, social and individual studies in the context of the Practice of Coexistence in Islamic Culture, as well as develop friendship and brotherhood relations between Indonesia, Azerbaijan, and Türkiye and other countries. The goal of the conference was to further efforts toward a shared human future founded on the values of peace, particularly among Muslims.
